Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Guardianship and Advocacy Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, as follows:

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The sum of \$9,517,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to the Guardianship and Advocacy Commission for operational
8 expenses of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018.

9 Section 5. The sum of \$2,400,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Guardianship and
11 Advocacy Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy Commission for
12 services pursuant to Section 5 of the Guardianship and Advocacy
13 Act.

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
15 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General
16 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
17 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
