

100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2017 and 2018 SB2279

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 500/20-7 new

Amends the Illinois Procurement Code. Provides that neither the State of Illinois nor an agency thereof shall enter into a contract, nor shall a contract be awarded, if there is not, prior to entering into such contract, an appropriation enacted for the funding of that contract. Provides that the State contract funding requirement applies to State contracts which may be entered into on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act.

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by adding Section 20-7 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 500/20-7 new)
- 7 Sec. 20-7. State contract funding. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, if a State contract is to be funded 8 9 from State sources, neither the State of Illinois nor an agency thereof shall enter into a contract, nor shall a contract be 10 awarded, if there is not, prior to entering into such contract, 11 12 an appropriation enacted for the funding of that contract. The provisions of this Section apply to State contracts which may 13 14 be entered into on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly. 15
