2	course required by this Section shall be conducted by the
3	Office of the Comptroller, or its designees, under rules,
4	regulations, procedures, policies, requirements, and standards
5	as prescribed from time to time by the Office of the
6	<u>Comptroller.</u>
7	(c) The Office of the Comptroller, in consultation with the
8	Illinois Municipal League and other designated entities, shall
9	establish guidelines and procedures to permit any person

10 <u>elected or appointed as a member of a municipal governing</u> 11 <u>authority after January 1 of a calendar year or any person who</u> 12 <u>is otherwise unable to attend or complete the training and</u> 13 <u>education course when offered by the program due to medical</u> 14 <u>disability, providential cause, or any other reason deemed</u> 15 <u>sufficient by such committee, to comply with the applicable</u> 16 training and education course requirements.

(d) All persons elected as members of a municipal governing 17 authority, who were not serving as members of a municipal 18 governing authority before the effective date of this 19 20 amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly, shall enroll in, 21 attend, and satisfactorily complete a course of training and education on matters pertaining to the administration and 22 operations of municipal governments. The course of training and 23 24 education shall include, but not be limited to, orientation in 25 local government finance and budgeting; methods of taxation; 26 planning; public works and utilities; parks and recreation;

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1 <u>environmental management; public safety; personnel management;</u>
2 <u>responsiveness to the community; the ethics, duties, and</u>
3 <u>responsibilities of members of a municipal governing authority</u>
4 <u>or a chief executive officer; and any other matters as may be</u>
5 <u>deemed necessary and appropriate.</u>

6 All expenses incurred by a newly elected member of a municipal governing authority related to the course of training 7 and education authorized and required by subsection (b), 8 9 including the reasonable costs of housing, travel, and meals, 10 shall be paid from public funds appropriated for such purposes. 11 All expenses not paid for by State funds shall be paid from 12 municipal funds by the municipal authority whose newly elected 13 member or members shall attend the course.

15 Sec. 4. Training and education course program report. On or before February 1 of each year, the Office of the Comptroller, 16 or its designee, shall file a report to the Governor. The 17 report shall include a summary of the accomplishments of the 18 program established under Section 3 during the preceding 19 20 calendar year, including, but not limited to, the total number 21 of members of a municipal governing authority who attended the training and education course offered by the program; an 22 outline of the program for the current calendar year; an 23 24 evaluation of the program and services offered by the program; 25 and recommendations, if any, for legislation as may be

1 necessary to improve the program and services offered by the

2 program.".
