

100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2017 and 2018 SB2447

Introduced 1/30/2018, by Sen. Laura M. Murphy

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5-30.6 new

Amends the Medical Assistance Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that no later than January 1, 2019, the Auditor General shall initiate a performance audit of the Department of Healthcare and Family Services to determine the Department's compliance with certain requirements concerning Medicaid Managed Care Entities. Provides that the determinations shall include, but not be limited to: (i) whether the Department has developed and applied standardized quality performance measures to Medicaid Managed Care Entities; (ii) whether it has developed and implemented algorithms for automatic assignment of Medicaid enrollees into managed care entities; and (iii) whether the standardized quality performance measures and algorithms developed by the Department use measurable quality metrics, are developed and applied according to the statutory criteria, and are adequately documented. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 5-30.6 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-30.6 new)
- Sec. 5-30.6. Performance audits. No later than January 1, 2019, the Auditor General shall initiate a performance audit of 8 9 the Department of Healthcare and Family Services to determine the Department's compliance with the requirements of Section 10 5-30.3. The determinations shall include, but not be limited 11 to: (i) whether the Department has developed and applied 12 standardized quality performance measures to Medicaid Managed 13 14 Care Entities; (ii) whether it has developed and implemented algorithms for automatic assignment of Medicaid enrollees into 15 managed care entities; and (iii) whether the standardized 16 quality performance measures and algorithms developed by the 17 Department use measurable quality metrics, are developed and 18 19 applied according to the statutory criteria, and are adequately 20 documented.
- 21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 22 becoming law.
