SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/12-209

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 12-209

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a back-up lamp equipped on a motor vehicle shall emit a white or amber light without glare. Effective January 1, 2019.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 12-209 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/12-209) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 12-209)
- 7 Sec. 12-209. Additional Lighting Equipment.
- 8 (a) Any motor vehicle may be equipped with not more than 2
- 9 side cowl or fender lamps which shall emit an amber or white
- 10 light without glare.
- 11 (b) Any motor vehicle may be equipped with not more than
- one running board courtesy lamp on each side thereof which
- shall emit a white or amber light without glare.
- 14 (c) Any motor vehicle may be equipped with one or more
- 15 back-up lamps either separately or in combination with other
- lamps which shall emit a white or amber light without glare;
- but any such back-up lamp or lamps shall not be lighted when
- 18 the motor vehicle is in forward motion.

- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
- 21 1, 2019.
