SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 505/17

from Ch. 23, par. 5017

Amends the Children and Family Services Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the Youth and Community Services Program.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is amended by changing Section 17 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 505/17) (from Ch. 23, par. 5017)
- Sec. 17. Youth and Community Services Program. The The 8 Department of Human Services shall develop a State program for 9 youth and community services which will assure that youth who come into contact or may come into contact with the child 10 welfare and the juvenile justice systems will have access to 11 12 community, prevention, diversion, emergency needed independent living services. The term "youth" means a person 13 14 under the age of 19 years. The term "homeless youth" means a youth who cannot be reunited with his or her family and is not 15 16 in a safe and stable living situation. This Section shall not 17 be construed to require the Department of Human Services to provide services under this Section to any homeless youth who 18 19 is at least 18 years of age but is younger than 19 years of age; however, the Department may, in its discretion, provide 20 21 services under this Section to any such homeless youth.
- 22 (a) The goals of the program shall be to:
- 23 (1) maintain children and youths in their own

- (2) eliminate unnecessary categorical funding of programs by funding more comprehensive and integrated programs;
 - (3) encourage local volunteers and voluntary associations in developing programs aimed at preventing and controlling juvenile delinquency;
 - (4) address voids in services and close service gaps;
 - (5) develop program models aimed at strengthening the relationships between youth and their families and aimed at developing healthy, independent lives for homeless youth;
 - (6) contain costs by redirecting funding to more comprehensive and integrated community-based services; and
 - (7) coordinate education, employment, training and other programs for youths with other State agencies.
- 16 (b) The duties of the Department under the program shall be to:
 - (1) design models for service delivery by local communities;
 - (2) test alternative systems for delivering youth services;
 - (3) develop standards necessary to achieve and maintain, on a statewide basis, more comprehensive and integrated community-based youth services;
 - (4) monitor and provide technical assistance to local boards and local service systems;

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1	(5) assist local organizations in developing programs
2	which address the problems of youths and their families
3	through direct services, advocacy with institutions, and
4	improvement of local conditions; and

- (6) develop a statewide adoption awareness campaign aimed at pregnant teenagers.
