Introduced 7/25/2018, by Sen. Wm. Sam McCann

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends Public Act 100-586. Provides that an appropriation from the Road Fund is made to the Illinois Department of Transportation for various purposes in specified Department districts (rather than for a grant to the Chicago Department of Transportation for infrastructure improvements). Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. "An Act making appropriations", Public Act 100-
5 586, approved June 4, 2018, is amended by changing Section 105
6 of Article 144 as follows:

9 Sec. 105. The sum of \$180,000,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Road Fund to the
11 Department of Transportation for preliminary engineering and
12 construction engineering and contract costs of construction,
13 including reconstruction, extension and improvement of State
14 highways, arterial highways, roads, access areas, roadside
15 shelters, rest areas, fringe parking facilities, and sanitary
16 facilities and such other purposes as provided by the Illinois
17 Highway Code; for purposes allowed or required by Title 23 of
18 the U.S. Code; for bikeways as provided by Public Act 78-850;
19 for land acquisition and signboard removal and control,
20 junkyard removal and control, and preservation of natural
21 beauty; and for capital improvements that directly facilitate
22 an effective vehicle weight enforcement program, such as scales
23 (fixed and portable), scale pits and scale installations and

1 scale houses, in accordance with applicable laws and
2 regulations for the Improvement Program as approximated below:
