13 Library Board, and many District 200 referendum committees; he
14 was President of the District 200 Backers Club for two years;
15 he was on the Memorial Hospital Foundation Board, where served
16 as President in 1995; he also sat on the Board of Governors of
17 Centegra Health System for over 20 years, where he was Chairman
18 from 2000 to 2002; and

19 WHEREAS, Luke Johnsos served many years as an usher at
20 Saint Mary Catholic Church in Woodstock; and

1 WHEREAS, Luke Johnsos enjoyed playing golf and rooting for
2 the Chicago Bears and the Michigan State University Spartans;
