1 SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to
3 learn of the death of Nancy Hoey Hanson of River Forest, who
4 passed away on July 12, 2017, at the age of 77; and

5 WHEREAS, Nancy Hoey Hanson was born to John Joseph and
6 Grace Pigott Hoey on April 25, 1940; and

7 WHEREAS, Nancy Hoey Hanson was an active, caring member of
8 her faith community, serving as president of the First
9 Presbyterian Church of Oak Park Guild; and

10 WHEREAS, Nancy Hoey Hanson devoted her time to bettering
11 the lives of those in her neighborhood, especially the children
12 of Oak Park and River Forest; she was a member of the board of
13 directors of the Oak Park and River Forest Day Nursery and
14 helped organize referenda for the River Forest Elementary
15 Schools and the Oak Park and River Forest High School; and

16 WHEREAS, Nancy Hoey Hanson was heavily involved in
17 philanthropy as a member of the Community Chest of Oak Park and
18 River Forest; she served on the Community Chest's Board of
19 Governors, as campaign chairman, and as president; and

20 WHEREAS, Nancy Hoey Hanson supported the Art Institute of

1 Chicago as a member and then chairman of the board of directors
2 of the OPRF Community Associates and as executive chair of the
3 executive board of Community Associates; and

4 WHEREAS, Nancy Hoey Hanson served as a member and president
5 of the Philanthropic Educational Organization's Oak Park
6 Chapter BI, which promoted educational opportunities for
7 women; and

8 WHEREAS, Nancy Hoey Hanson was preceded in death by her
9 parents and her brother, John Bartley Hoey; and

10 WHEREAS, Nancy Hoey Hanson is survived by her devoted
11 husband of 55 years, David Louis Hanson; her beloved sons, Mark
12 Louis (Burch) Hanson and United States Navy Captain Christopher
13 John (Catherine) Hanson; her cherished grandchildren, William
14 Louis and Edward McCutchen Hanson and Caroline Grace and Chase
15 Edward Hanson; and many wonderfully supportive neighbors and
16 friends; therefore, be it
