SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-805

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-805

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Establishes the registration fee for electric vehicles at no more than \$216.00 per year (previously \$35 for a 2-year term) and creates a separate registration fee not to exceed \$158.50 per year for hybrid vehicles. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 3-805 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-805) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-805)

Sec. 3-805. Electric vehicles. The owner of a motor 7 vehicle of the first division or a motor vehicle of the second 8 9 division weighing 8,000 pounds or less propelled by an electric engine and not utilizing motor fuel, may register such vehicle 10 for a fee not to exceed \$216.00 for a one-year \$35 for a 2-year 11 12 registration period. The owner of a plug-in hybrid electric 13 motor vehicle that operates on electric and gasoline, and has a 14 battery that can be recharged from an external source, may register the vehicle for a fee not to exceed \$158.50 for a 15 16 one-year registration period. The Secretary may, in his 17 discretion, prescribe that electric vehicle registration plates be issued for an indefinite term, such term to 18 19 correspond to the term of registration plates issued generally, provided in Section 3-414.1. 20 In no event may the as 21 registration fee for electric vehicles exceed \$18 per 22 registration year.
