## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 22-27 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/22-27)
- Sec. 22-27. World War II, Korean Conflict, and Vietnam Conflict veterans; service member killed in action; diplomas.
- 9 (a) Upon request, the school board of any district that
  10 maintains grades 10 through 12 may award a diploma to any
  11 honorably discharged veteran who:
- 12 (1) served in the armed forces of the United States
  13 during World War II, the Korean Conflict, or the Vietnam
  14 Conflict;
- 15 (2) resided within an area currently within the district;
- 17 (3) left high school before graduating in order to 18 serve in the armed forces of the United States; and
- 19 (4) has not received a high school diploma.
- 20 <u>(a-5) Upon request, the school board of a school district</u>
  21 <u>that maintains grades 10 through 12 may posthumously award a</u>
  22 <u>diploma to any service member who was killed in action while</u>
  23 performing active military duty with the armed forces of the

- United States if all of the following criteria have been met:
- 2 <u>(1) He or she resided in an area currently within the</u>
- 3 <u>district.</u>

- 5 serve in the armed forces of the United States.
- 6 (3) He or she did not receive a high school diploma.
- 7 (b) The State Board of Education and the Department of
