Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Removes "not the actual mileage" language from the application for a corrected certificate of title. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 3-111.1 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-111.1) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-111.1)
- 7 Sec. 3-111.1. Corrected certificates. An application for a
- 8 corrected certificate of title must state the current vehicle
- 9 odometer reading at the time of application and that the stated
- 10 odometer reading is one of the following: actual mileage, not
- 11 the actual mileage or mileage is in excess of its mechanical
- 12 limits. The corrected certificate issued under this Section
- 13 shall contain the notation "corrected".

- 15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 16 becoming law.
