SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 105/4.1 new

Amends the Public Officer Prohibited Activities Act. Provides that no officer, employee, or agent of a unit of local government may attempt to withhold disclosure to the public of information relating to tax incentives and other financial incentives by using a non-disclosure agreement. Defines "tax incentive". Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Public Officer Prohibited Activities Act is
amended by adding Section 4.1 as follows:

(50 ILCS 105/4.1 new) 6 7 Sec. 4.1. Non-disclosure agreements. (a) As used in this Section, "tax incentive" includes, but 8 9 is not limited to, any tax incentive authorized by law that by exemption, exclusion, <u>deduction</u>, <u>allowance</u>, <u>credit</u>, 10 preferential tax rate, abatement, or other device reduces the 11 amount of tax revenues that would otherwise accrue to the unit 12 of local government. 13 14 (b) No officer, employee, or agent of a unit of local government may attempt to withhold disclosure to the public of 15 information relating to tax incentives and other financial 16 17 incentives by using a non-disclosure agreement. Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 18
