SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 105/4.1 new

Amends the Public Officer Prohibited Activities Act. Provides that an elected or appointed official of a unit of local government many not hire or appoint himself or herself to a second position in the unit of local government if the second position is a salaried or hourly position. Allows the governing body of the unit of local government to hire or appoint an elected or appointed official to a second position in the unit of local government with a salary or hourly wages by ordinance or resolution if the ordinance or resolution states the salary or total compensation of an hourly position. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Public Officer Prohibited Activities Act is
amended by adding Section 4.1 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 105/4.1 new)

7 <u>Sec. 4.1. Official hiring self.</u>

8 <u>(a) An elected or appointed official of a unit of local</u> 9 government many not hire or appoint himself or herself to a 10 <u>second position in the unit of local government if the second</u> 11 <u>position is a salaried or hourly position.</u>

12 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the governing body of 13 the unit of local government may hire or appoint an elected or 14 appointed official to a second position in the unit of local 15 government with a salary or hourly wages by ordinance or 16 resolution if the ordinance or resolution states the salary or 17 total compensation of an hourly position.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
