## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 63. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for all costs
- 4 associated with homeland security and emergency preparedness
- 5 and response, including grants and operational expenses.
- 6 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 7 1, 2019.
