Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Child Protective Investigator and Child
Welfare Specialist Certification Act of 1987 is amended by
changing Section 5 as follows:

7 (225 ILCS 420/5) (from Ch. 111, par. 7655)

8 Sec. 5. In addition to the requirements of Section 4, a 9 person shall be qualified to be certified if he or she:

10 (a) has passed an examination approved by the Department to 11 determine his fitness to perform the duties of or otherwise 12 function as a child protective investigator or child welfare 13 specialist;

(b) is at least 18 years of age;

15 (c) has completed the curriculum of study or training, 16 developed pursuant to Section 4, at the Department, college or 17 other institution that is approved to do business in this 18 State; and

(d) has a bachelor's degree in an area related to human services such as law enforcement, police science, criminology, social work, early childhood development or psychology, provided that this subsection (d) shall not apply to persons employed by the Department prior to the effective date of this
