### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 10/5.11 new

Amends the Child Care Act of 1969. Provides that day care centers, day care homes, and group day care homes may not require a parent or guardian applying to enroll his or her child in a day care program to pay an application fee or holding fee if the parent or guardian is receiving child care assistance through a private or public entity. Effective immediately.

3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Child Care Act of 1969 is amended by adding  
5 Section 5.11 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 10/5.11 new)

7 Sec. 5.11. Day care application fees. Day care centers, day  
8 care homes, and group day care homes may not require a parent  
9 or guardian applying to enroll his or her child in a day care  
10 program to pay an application fee or holding fee if the parent  
11 or guardian is receiving child care assistance through a  
12 private or public entity.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
14 becoming law.
