11	there is no expectation of com	npensation;
12	(2) the internship provide	es training that is similar to
13	that which is given in a	an educational environment,
14	including the clinical an	d other hands-on training
15	provided by educational institutions;	
16	(3) the internship is t	tied to the intern's formal
17	education program by integrat	ted coursework or the receipt

1	of academic credit;
2	(4) the internship accommodates an intern's academic
3	commitments, if any, by corresponding to the academic
4	<pre>calendar;</pre>
5	(5) the internship's duration is limited to the period
6	during which the internship provides the intern with
7	beneficial learning;
8	(6) the intern's work complements, rather than
9	displaces, the work of paid employees, while providing
10	significant educational benefits to the intern; and
11	(7) the intern and the employer understand that the
12	internship is conducted without entitlement to a paid job
13	at the conclusion of the internship.
14	"Internship" also includes any relationship that the
15	employer designates as an internship.
