Makes Appropriations for the operational expenses, awards, grants, permanent improvements, and probation reimbursements of the Supreme Court for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021. Effective July 1, 2020.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. In addition to other sums appropriated, the sum
5 of \$434,679,675, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
6 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Supreme Court
7 for operational expenses, awards, grants, permanent
8 improvements and probation reimbursements for the fiscal year
9 ending June 30, 2021.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$29,131,200, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Mandatory
12 Arbitration Fund to the Supreme Court for Mandatory Arbitration
13 Programs.

14 Section 15. The sum of \$708,800, or so much thereof as may
15 be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreign Language
16 Interpreter Fund to the Supreme Court for the Foreign Language
17 Interpreter Program.

18 Section 20. The sum of \$1,032,500, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Lawyers' Assistance
20 Program Fund to the Supreme Court for lawyers' assistance

1 programs.

2 Section 25. The sum of \$13,793,900, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court
4 Special Purposes Fund to the Supreme Court for the oversight
5 and management of electronic filing, case management systems,
6 and committees and commissions of the Supreme Court.

7 Section 30. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court
9 Federal Projects Fund to the Supreme Court for expenses
10 relating to various Federal projects.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2020.
