1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1385

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1385 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Law Enforcement Officer-Worn Body Camera
5 Act is amended by changing Section 10-5 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 706/10-5)

7 Sec. 10-5. Purpose. The ~~The~~ General Assembly recognizes
8 that trust and mutual respect between law enforcement agencies
9 and the communities they protect and serve are essential to
10 effective policing and the integrity of our criminal justice
11 system. The General Assembly recognizes that officer-worn body
12 cameras have developed as a technology that has been used and
13 experimented with by police departments. Officer-worn body
14 cameras will provide state-of-the-art evidence collection and
15 additional opportunities for training and instruction.
16 Further, officer-worn body cameras may provide impartial

1 evidence and documentation to settle disputes and allegations
2 of officer misconduct. Ultimately, the uses of officer-worn
3 body cameras will help collect evidence while improving
4 transparency and accountability, and strengthening public
5 trust. The General Assembly creates these standardized
6 protocols and procedures for the use of officer-worn body
7 cameras to ensure that this technology is used in furtherance
8 of these goals while protecting individual privacy and
9 providing consistency in its use across this State.
