

## 101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2019 and 2020 SB2755

Introduced 2/4/2020, by Sen. Brian W. Stewart

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 340/4

from Ch. 15, par. 504

Amends the Voluntary Payroll Deductions Act of 1983. Provides that an employee may authorize the withholding of a portion of his or her salary or wages for contribution to a maximum number of 10 (currently, 4) specified organizations. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Voluntary Payroll Deductions Act of 1983 is amended by changing Section 4 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 340/4) (from Ch. 15, par. 504)

Sec. 4. Employee withholding. An employee may authorize the withholding of a portion of his or her salary or wages for contribution to a maximum number of 10 4 organizations described in paragraphs (b) and (c) of Section 3 of this Act. A department, board, body, agency or commission may direct the State Comptroller to deduct, and the University of Illinois, Illinois University, Chicago Southern State University, Eastern Illinois University, Governors State University, Illinois State University, Northeastern Illinois University, Northern Illinois University, and Western Illinois University may deduct, upon written request of a State employee, for each regular payroll period, from the salary or wages of the employee the amount specified in the written request for payment to the organization designated by the employee. The moneys so deducted shall be paid over promptly to organizations designated by the employee by means of warrants drawn by the State Comptroller, the University of Illinois,

- 5 against the appropriation for personal services of the
- 6 department, board, body, agency or commission by which such
- 7 employee is employed.
- 8 Such deductions may be made notwithstanding that the
- 9 compensation paid in cash to such employee is thereby reduced
- 10 below the minimum prescribed by law. Payment to such employee
- of compensation less such deduction shall constitute a full and
- 12 complete discharge and acquittance of all claims and demands
- whatsoever for the services rendered by such employee during
- the period covered by such payment.
- 15 Such request for deduction may be withdrawn at any time by
- 16 filing a written notification of withdrawal with the
- department, board, body, agency or commission, the University
- 18 of Illinois, Southern Illinois University, Chicago State
- 19 University, Eastern Illinois University, Governors State
- 20 University, Illinois State University, Northeastern Illinois
- 21 University, Northern Illinois University, or Western Illinois
- 22 University, by which such employee is employed.
