Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Provides that January 28 of each year is designated as Data Privacy Day to be observed throughout the State as a day in recognition of the right of Illinois citizens to be secure in the privacy of their personal data.

4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
5 adding Section 193 as follows:

7 Sec. 193. Data Privacy Day. January 28 of each year is
8 designated as Data Privacy Day to be observed throughout the
9 State as a day in recognition of the right of Illinois citizens
10 to be secure in the privacy of their personal data.
