SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 205/9.39 new

Amends the Board of Higher Education Act. Requires the Board of Higher Education to establish an online statewide direct admissions program to provide more high school seniors with the opportunity to obtain a postsecondary certificate or degree. Provides that the Board shall receive the grades of each high school student from district uploads to the Board. Provides that a student shall receive conditional acceptance to a public university or to a public community college based on his or her grade point average and college entrance examination scores relative to the benchmark grade point average and college entrance examination score set by the Board. Sets forth additional provisions of the program. Effective January 1, 2022.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Board of Higher Education Act is amended by 5 adding Section 9.39 as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 9.39. Direct admissions program.</u>

(a) The Board of Higher Education shall create an online 8 9 statewide direct admissions program to provide more high school 10 seniors with the opportunity to obtain a postsecondary certificate or degree. The Board shall model the program after 11 the Direct Admissions initiative in Idaho. The Board shall 12 receive the grades of each high school student from school 13 14 district uploads to the State Board of Education. The Board shall establish a benchmark grade point average and college 15 16 entrance examination score to determine a student's admission eligibility. A student at or above the benchmark shall be 17 conditionally admitted, pending the student's successful 18 19 completion of high school, to the following public universities: University of Illinois, Southern Illinois 20 21 University, Chicago State University, Eastern Illinois 22 University, Governors State University, Illinois State University, Northeastern Illinois University, Northern 23

Illinois University, Western Illinois University, or any other public university or college now or hereafter established or authorized by the General Assembly. A student who does not meet the benchmark grade point average and college entrance examination score shall be conditionally admitted, pending the student's successful completion of high school, to the public community college located in his or her district.

(b) A student and his or her family shall receive 8 9 notification separately about the student's conditional 10 acceptance. The notification shall encourage the student to research the academic, professional, technical, and vocational 11 12 programs offered by the public universities and community colleges located in the State. The student must complete and 13 14 submit a direct admissions application for admission to the institution or institutions of his or her choice. The student 15 16 shall not be required to pay an application fee for admission 17 to the institution or institutions to which he or she applies. Any application fee associated with the direct admissions 18 19 application form shall be credited on the student's first 20 tuition statement issued by the institution.

21 (c) The Board shall adopt any rules necessary to implement
22 this program.
