McIntosh at the age of ten; there, he served as a junior 9 usher; he was educated in the Waukegan Public School System and 10 graduated Waukegan East School from High in 1989; 11 affectionately known as the "Comic" in high school, he 12 participated in several sports, including track, basketball, and football, as well as JROTC; he expressed his musical talent 13 14 by playing the flute in the Waukegan High School Band; the 15 value of hard work was instilled in him at an early age; he had a paper route with the News Sun, was a golf caddy for Glenbrook 16 17 Country Club, and worked at Pete's Fruit Market in Waukegan; 18 and
