9	(a) As the State administrator of	benefits provided under
10	the federally funded Supplemental Nut	rition Assistance Program
11	(SNAP), the Department of Human Se	ervices shall track and
12	collect data on the scope and frequence	cy of SNAP benefits fraud
13	in this State where a SNAP recipien	t's benefits are stolen
14	from the recipient's electronic ber	nefits transfer card by
15	means of card skimming, card cloning	, or some other similar
16	fraudulent method. The Department sh	all specifically keep a

1 record of every report made to the Department by a SNAP
2 recipient alleging the theft of benefits due to no fault of the
3 recipient, the benefit amount stolen, and, if practicable, how
4 those stolen benefits were used and the location of those
5 thefts.

6 (b) The Department shall report its findings to the General Assembly on an annual basis beginning on January 1, 7 2024. The Department shall file an annual report no later than 8 9 the 60th day of the following year following each reporting 10 period. A SNAP recipient's personally identifiable information 11 shall be excluded from the reports consistent with State and federal privacy protections. Each annual report shall also be 12 13 posted on the Department's official website.

14 <u>(c) If the Department determines that a SNAP recipient has</u> 15 <u>made a substantiated report of stolen benefits due to card</u> 16 <u>skimming, card cloning, or some other similar fraudulent</u> 17 <u>method, the Department shall refer the matter to the State's</u> 18 <u>Attorney who has jurisdiction over the alleged theft or fraud</u> 19 <u>and shall provide any assistance to that State's Attorney in</u> 20 the prosecution of the alleged theft or fraud.".
