Appropriates \$750,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Education for grants to fund a psychomotor skill-based cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training program for all public schools and to cover the costs of required CPR training in high schools. Effective July 1, 2023.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$750,000, or so much of that sum as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
6 to the State Board of Education for grants to fund a psychomotor
7 skill-based cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training
8 program for all public schools and to cover the costs of
9 required CPR training in high schools.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
11 2023.
