1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

8 for the past 38 years; and

10 non-profit organizations, including the Rock River Valley Food  
11 Pantry, JustGoods fair trade market, Rockford Work Camps, and  
12 Harm Reduction Outreach; and

13 WHEREAS, Stanley Campbell is a tireless advocate for a  
14 variety of important issues, including helping those less  
15 fortunate, building safer communities, and increasing  
16 involvement in mission and peace issues; beyond bringing  
17 awareness to these and other pressing issues, he is never  
18 afraid to do the work necessary to find long-term, meaningful  
19 solutions; and

20 WHEREAS, Stanley Campbell has overseen the organization of  
21 numerous community events, including the CROP Hunger Walk and

1 Good Friday Walk for Justice, has established lasting  
2 community partnerships, and has strengthened collaboration  
3 between leaders of faith in pursuit of the causes of peace and  
4 justice for the Rockford community; and

5 WHEREAS, Stanley Campbell will retire from the Rockford  
6 Urban Ministries in the summer of 2023, ending an impressive  
7 career dedicated to uplifting the community and people he  
8 loves so dearly; therefore, be it

10 HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
