- 1 AN ACT relating to education funding.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Fund Education First Act.

Retirement System.

- 6 Section 5. Educational appropriations. Beginning with fiscal year 2004 and in each fiscal year thereafter, subject 7 to the provisions of Section 10 of this Act, the General 8 Assembly shall appropriate for educational programs an amount 9 that is equal to or exceeds the sum of: (1) the total amount 10 appropriated from general funds for educational programs 11 during the fiscal year immediately preceding the fiscal year 12 13 for which the appropriation is being made; and (2) 51% of total new general funds available for spending from estimated 14 growth in revenues and funds available because of budgeted 15 16 program growth and decline in the fiscal year for which the appropriation is being made, excluding annual 17 State contributions to the Teachers' Retirement System of the State 18 Illinois, the Public School Teachers' Pension and 19
- 22 Section 10. State and federal funding. State funding for educational programs shall continue to be appropriated 23 pursuant to the formula established in Section 5 of this Act 24 until the sum of State and federal spending represents 25 26 one-half of the total revenues available from local, State, and federal sources for elementary and secondary education 27 28 programs for the current fiscal year, as estimated by the State Superintendent of Education. 29

- 1 Section 15. Allocation. Two-thirds of the new general
- 2 funds to be appropriated pursuant to clause (2) of Section 5
- 3 of this Act shall be appropriated for elementary and
- 4 secondary educational programs and one-third shall be

- 6 Section 20. Governor's budget. Beginning with fiscal
- 7 year 2005 and in each fiscal year thereafter, the Governor
- 8 shall include in his or her annual budget an allocation for
- 9 elementary and secondary education and higher education that
- 10 conforms to the provisions of this Act.
- 11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 12 becoming law.
