- 4 Section 5. The Department of Human Services Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 10-35 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 1305/10-35 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 10-35. Disability database. The Department of</u>
- 8 Human Services shall contract with an entity experienced in
- 9 applied research to compile a cross-disability database of
- 10 <u>disabled Illinois residents who are potential beneficiaries</u>
- of the "most integrated setting" requirement of the Americans
- 12 <u>with Disabilities Act as construed by the United States</u>
- 13 <u>Supreme Court in Olmstead v. L.C. ex rel Zimring, 119 S. Ct.</u>
- 14 <u>2176 (1999). Within 30 days after the effective date of this</u>
- amendatory Act of the 92nd General Assembly, the Secretary of
- 16 <u>Human Services shall appoint a 7-member cross-disability</u>
- 17 <u>advisory committee to make recommendations to the Department</u>
- 18 regarding the compilation of the database. The advisory
- 19 <u>committee members shall receive no compensation but may be</u>
