AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by 5 changing Section 39-1 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/39-1) (from Ch. 38, par. 39-1)

7 Sec. 39-1. Criminal Usury.

8 (a) <u>A</u> Any person commits criminal usury when, in 9 exchange for either a loan of money or other property or 10 forbearance from the collection of such a loan, he <u>or she</u> 11 knowingly contracts for or receives from an individual, 12 directly or indirectly, interest, discount or other 13 consideration at a rate greater than 20% per annum either 14 before or after the maturity of the loan.

(b) When a person has in his personal or constructive possession records, memoranda, or other documentary record of usurious loans it shall be prima facie evidence that he has violated Subsection 39-1(a) hereof.
