Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by
changing Section 1-3 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/1-3) (from Ch. 38, par. 1-3)

7 Sec. 1-3. Applicability of common law. No conduct 8 constitutes an offense unless it is described as an offense 9 in this Code or in another statute of this State. However, 10 this provision does not affect the power of a court to punish 11 for contempt or to employ <u>a</u> any sanction authorized by law 12 for the enforcement of an order or civil judgment.
