19	Sec. 4.3. Auction certificate of notification. Any equine
20	owner who sells or otherwise transfers an equine in an equine
21	auction must sign, upon consignment, a certificate of
22	notification acknowledging that he or she has been made aware
23	of the fact that the auctioned equine may be sold for

1 slaughter. A copy of the certificate of notification shall 2 accompany the equine upon sale or transfer. The person or 3 entity conducting the auction shall provide the certificate of 4 notification.
