The Children's Health Insurance Program Act is 5 amended by changing Section 22 as follows: (215 ILCS 106/22) 6 7 Sec. 22. Enrollment in program; funding for community 8 organizations. (a) The Department shall develop procedures to allow 9 community providers, schools, youth service agencies, 10 employers, labor unions, local chambers of commerce, and 11 religious organizations to assist in enrolling children in the 12 13 Program. 14 (b) Subject to specific appropriation, the Department shall provide funding to community organizations for outreach 15 16 activities, which could include assistance in completing the application process and forwarding the application to the State 17 18 for processing. Community organizations will be required to provide specific services and will be held accountable for 19 providing those services.
