- 4 Section 5. The Vital Records Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 25.5 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 25.5. Death Certificate Surcharge Fund. The
- 8 additional \$2 fee for certified copies of death certificates
- 9 and fetal death certificates must be deposited into the Death
- 10 Certificate Surcharge Fund, a special fund created in the
- 11 State treasury. Beginning 30 days after the effective date
- of this amendatory Act of the 92nd General Assembly and until
