- 8 means such period of seven consecutive days as the Director

- 11 A. Calendar week, or
- B. Any seven consecutive day period with respect to
- which no wages are payable to an individual and during which
- 14 he performs no services, which occurs within two calendar
- weeks in each of which he is not unemployed; or
- 16 C. Any seven consecutive day period which ends after
- September 26, 1959, and before October 3, 1959.
- 18 The Director may by regulation prescribe that a week
- shall be deemed to be "in," "within," or "during" any benefit
- year which includes the greater part of such week.
