AN ACT in regard to vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
changing Section 11-1301.3 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1301.3) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-1301.3)
7 Sec. 11-1301.3. Unauthorized use of parking places
8 reserved for persons with disabilities.

9 (a) No person may It-shall-be--prohibited--to park any motor vehicle which is not properly displaying registration 10 plates or decals issued to a person with disabilities, 11 as defined by Section 1-159.1, pursuant to Sections 3-616, 12 13 11-1301.1 or 11-1301.2, or to a disabled veteran pursuant to Section 3-609 of this Act, as evidence that the vehicle is 14 15 operated by or for a person with disabilities or disabled 16 veteran, in any parking place, including any private or public offstreet parking facility, specifically reserved, by 17 18 the posting of an official sign as designated under Section 19 11-301, for motor vehicles displaying such registration 20 plates. It shall be prohibited to park any motor vehicle in a designated access aisle adjacent to any parking place 21 22 specifically reserved for persons with disabilities, by the posting of an official sign as designated under Section 23 11-301, for motor vehicles displaying such registration 24 plates. When using the parking privileges for persons with 25 disabilities, the parking decal or device must be displayed 26 27 properly in the vehicle where it is clearly visible to law enforcement personnel, either hanging from the rearview 28 29 mirror or placed on the dashboard of the vehicle in clear view. An individual with a vehicle properly displaying a 30 31 person with disabilities license plate or parking decal or

1 device issued to a disabled person under Sections 3-616, 2 11-1301.1, or 11-1301.2 is in violation of this Section if the person is not the authorized holder of a person with 3 4 disabilities license plate or parking decal or device and is not transporting the authorized holder of a person with 5 6 disabilities license plate or parking decal or device to or 7 from the parking location and the person uses the person with 8 disabilities license plate or parking decal or device to 9 exercise any privileges granted through the person with disabilities license plates or parking decals or devices 10 11 under this Code. Any motor vehicle properly displaying a person with disabilities license plate or a person with 12 or 13 disabilities parking decal device containing the International symbol of access issued to persons 14 with 15 disabilities by any local authority, state, district, 16 territory or foreign country shall be recognized by State and local authorities as a valid license plate or device and 17 receive the same parking privileges as residents of this 18 19 State.

Any person or local authority owning or operating 20 (b) 21 any public or private offstreet parking facility may, after 22 notifying the police or sheriff's department, remove or cause 23 to be removed to the nearest garage or other place of safety any vehicle parked within a stall or space reserved for use 24 25 by a person with disabilities which does not display person with disabilities registration plates or a special decal or 26 device as required under this Section. 27

Any person found guilty of violating the provisions 28 (C) this Section shall be fined \$100 in addition to any costs 29 of 30 or charges connected with the removal or storage of any motor vehicle authorized under this Section; but municipalities by 31 32 ordinance may impose a fine up to \$200 and shall display signs indicating the fine imposed. If the amount of the fine 33 34 is subsequently changed, the municipality shall change the

1 sign to indicate the current amount of the fine. It shall not 2 be a defense to a charge under this Section that the sign posted pursuant to this Section does not comply with the 3 4 technical requirements of Section 11-301, Department 5 regulations, or local ordinance if a reasonable person would 6 be made aware by the sign or notice on or near the parking 7 place that the place is reserved for a person with disabilities. 8

9 (d) Local authorities shall impose fines as established 10 in subsection (c) for violations of this Section.

(e) As used in this Section, "authorized holder" means an individual issued a person with disabilities license plate under Section 3-616 of this Code or an individual issued a person with disabilities parking decal or device under Section 11-1301.2 of this Code.
