Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

7 Sec. 4. Conveyor not in possession of lands. Any person claiming right or title to lands, tenements or hereditaments, 8 although he, she or they may be out of possession, and 9 notwithstanding there may be an adverse possession thereof, 10 may sell, convey and transfer his or her interest in and to 11 the same, in as full and complete a manner as if he or she 12 13 were in the actual possession of the lands and premises intended to be conveyed; and the grantee or grantees shall 14 have the same right of action for the recovery thereof, and 15 16 shall in all respects derive the same benefit and advantage therefrom, as if the grantor or grantors had been in the 17 actual possession at the time of executing the conveyance. 18
