- 1 AN ACT in relation to fire protection.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 11-10-2 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/11-10-2) (from Ch. 24, par. 11-10-2)
- 7 Sec. 11-10-2. <u>Department Foreign Fire Insurance Board</u>. A
- 8 <u>department foreign fire insurance board shall exist within</u>
- 9 <u>the fire department of each municipality with fewer</u> The
- 10 corporate--authorities--of--any--municipality-containing-less
- 11 than 250,000 inhabitants $\underline{\text{that}}$ which has an organized fire
- 12 department. The department shall provide shall--pass-an
- 13 ordinance-providing for the election of officers of the
- 14 department foreign fire insurance board by the members of the
- 15 department. All members of the department shall be eligible
- 16 to be elected as officers of the department foreign fire
- 17 insurance board. These officers shall include a treasurer,
- 18 and they shall make all needful rules and regulations with
- 19 respect to the department foreign fire insurance board and
- 20 the management of the money to be appropriated to the board.
- 21 The officers of the department foreign fire insurance board
- 22 shall develop and maintain a listing of those items that the
- 23 board feels are appropriate expenditures under this Act. All
- 24 of the money paid to the municipal treasurer as provided in
- 25 Section 11-10-1 shall be set apart and shall be appropriated
- 26 annually by the corporate authorities to the department
- 27 foreign fire insurance board. The treasurer of the
- 28 department foreign fire insurance board shall give a
- 29 sufficient bond to the municipality in which the fire
- 30 department is organized. This bond shall be approved by the
- 31 mayor or president, as the case may be, conditioned upon the

- 1 faithful performance by the treasurer of his or her duties
- 2 under the ordinance and the rules and regulations provided
- 3 for in this Section. The treasurer of the department foreign
- 4 fire insurance board shall receive the appropriated money and
- 5 shall pay out the money upon the order of the department
- 6 foreign fire insurance board for the maintenance, use, and
- 7 benefit of the department. As part of the annual municipal
- 8 audit, these funds shall be audited to verify that they have
- 9 <u>been properly appropriated to and held by the department</u>
- 10 <u>foreign fire insurance board and have been expended by that</u>
- 11 <u>board only</u> these-purchases-are for the maintenance, use, and
- 12 benefit of the department.
- 13 The provisions of this Section shall be the exclusive
- 14 power of the State, pursuant to subsection (h) of Section 6
- of Article VII of the Constitution.

- 17 Section 10. The Fire Protection District Act is amended
- 18 by adding Section 11h as follows:
- 19 (70 ILCS 705/11h new)
- 20 <u>Sec. 11h. Department foreign fire insurance board.</u>
- 21 <u>(a) A department foreign fire insurance board shall</u>
- 22 <u>exist within the fire department of each fire protection</u>
- 23 <u>district that has an organized fire department.</u>
- (b) The department shall provide for the election of
- 25 officers of the department foreign fire insurance board,
- 26 <u>including a treasurer. All members of the department shall</u>
- 27 <u>be eligible to vote for and be elected as officers of the</u>
- 28 <u>department foreign fire insurance board.</u>
- 29 <u>(c) The treasurer of the department foreign fire</u>
- 30 <u>insurance</u> board shall give a sufficient bond to the board of
- 31 <u>trustees of the fire protection district, conditioned upon</u>
- 32 the faithful performance by the treasurer of his or her

- 1 duties under this Section. This bond must be approved by the
- 2 <u>board of trustees of the fire protection district.</u>
- 3 (d) The officers of the department foreign fire
- 4 <u>insurance board shall develop and maintain a listing of those</u>
- 5 <u>items that the board feels are appropriate expenditures under</u>
- 6 this Section. The officers shall make all needful rules and
- 7 regulations with respect to the department foreign fire
- 8 <u>insurance board and the management of the money to be</u>
- 9 <u>appropriated to the board.</u>
- 10 (e) All of the money paid to the secretary of the fire
- 11 protection district under Section 11-10-1 of the Illinois
- 12 <u>Municipal Code shall be set apart and shall be appropriated</u>
- 13 <u>annually</u> by the board of trustees of the fire protection
- 14 <u>district to the department foreign fire insurance board.</u>
- 15 (f) The treasurer of the department foreign fire
- 16 <u>insurance board shall receive the appropriated money and</u>
- 17 <u>shall pay out the money upon the order of the department</u>
- 18 foreign fire insurance board for the maintenance, use, and
- 19 <u>benefit of the department</u>. As part of the fire protection
- 20 <u>district's annual audit, these funds shall be audited to</u>
- 21 verify that they have been properly appropriated to and held
- 22 by the department foreign fire insurance board and have been
- 23 expended by that board only for the maintenance, use, and
- 24 <u>benefit of the department.</u>
- 25 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 26 becoming law.
