AN ACT in relation to alcohol.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Liquor Control Act of 1934 is amended by
changing Section 6-14 as follows:

6 (235 ILCS 5/6-14) (from Ch. 43, par. 129)

7 Sec. 6-14. <u>Retail sales on Sundays.</u> No person shall sell at retail any alcoholic liquor on Sundays unless authorized 8 by general ordinance or resolution of the city council, 9 president and board of trustees, or county board, as the case 10 may be; provided, however that the city council, president 11 and board of trustees, or county board, as the case may be, 12 13 may further restrict the permissible hours for the sale of alcoholic liquors under such licenses in its political 14 subdivision as the public good and convenience may require. 15 16 (Source: P.A. 82-783.)
