- 8 <u>Sec. 50-25</u>. <u>Appropriation levels; revenue excesses</u>.
- 9 (a) Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the total
- 10 appropriations for a fiscal year submitted by the Governor
- 11 and adopted by the General Assembly for each State agency
- 12 <u>shall not exceed the amount of total appropriations for that</u>
- 13 agency for fiscal year 2004. This subsection does not apply
- 14 to elementary and secondary education appropriations subject
- to Section 50-20 (the Responsible Education Funding Law).
- 16 (b) Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, any State
- 17 <u>revenues received for a fiscal year in excess of an amount</u>
