- 1 AN ACT concerning elections.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 1A-20 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/1A-20 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 1A-20. Provisional ballots.</u>
- 8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code to
- 9 the contrary, the State Board of Elections shall adopt and
- 10 <u>election authorities shall implement procedures for the</u>
- 11 <u>casting and counting of provisional ballots at any election</u>
- 12 <u>in accordance with this Section.</u>
- 13 (b) A person claiming to be entitled to vote but whose
- 14 registration cannot be verified at the polling place shall be
- 15 given a provisional ballot. After the person has marked or
- otherwise cast the provisional ballot, the provisional ballot
- shall be placed in an envelope that indicates its provisional
- 18 <u>status and shall be kept separately from non-provisional</u>
- 19 <u>ballots. If the election authority cannot verify the person's</u>
- 20 <u>valid registration through comparison of the signature on the</u>

provisional ballot request with the signature on his or her

- 22 <u>registration application, the provisional ballot shall not be</u>
- 23 <u>counted. If the election authority verifies the person's</u>
- 24 <u>valid registration through comparison of the signature on the</u>
- 25 provisional ballot request with the signature on his or her
- 26 <u>registration application, the provisional ballot shall be</u>
- 27 <u>counted</u>.

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- 28 <u>(c) Attempted verification of the person's valid</u>
- 29 <u>registration must be timely and efficient. Judges at the</u>
- 30 polling place may be required to make a good faith effort to
- 31 <u>contact the election authority for verification at the</u>

- 1 person's request, and the election authority may be required
- 2 <u>to make a good faith effort to attempt verification before</u>
- 3 <u>the provisional ballot has been cast. Once a provisional</u>
- 4 <u>ballot is cast, the election authority must make timely and</u>
- 5 good faith efforts to verify the registration in order to
- 6 <u>include the provisional ballot in the official canvass of</u>
- 7 <u>ballots. If the person's signature on his or her provisional</u>
- 8 <u>ballot request varies from the signature on an otherwise</u>
- 9 <u>valid</u> registration application solely because of the
- 10 <u>substitution of initials for the first or middle name, the</u>
- 11 <u>election authority may not reject the provisional ballot as</u>
- 12 <u>that of an unqualified voter.</u>
- (d) A provisional ballot may be requested by a person
- 14 who has been provided an absentee ballot but who is unable to
- 15 <u>surrender to the election judge his or her uncast ballot. The</u>
- 16 provisional ballot shall not be counted if the absentee
- 17 <u>ballot has been cast.</u>
- 18 (e) An election authority must give notice to any person
- 19 who cast a provisional ballot that was not counted if the
- 20 reason the ballot was not counted was the person's lack of
- 21 <u>valid registration. The notice must explain the steps</u>
- 22 <u>necessary for the person to properly register.</u>
- 23 (f) To the extent possible, the rules adopted under this
- 24 <u>Section must apply to provisional ballots this Code's</u>
- 25 procedures for handling and counting other types of ballots,
- 26 <u>including the use of electronic voting systems.</u>
