- Sec. 17-26. Paternity fraud.
- 8 (a) A person commits the offense of paternity fraud
- 9 <u>when:</u>
- 10 <u>(1) he or she knowingly alleges that a person is</u>
- 11 <u>the biological father of a child; and</u>
- 12 <u>(2) he or she knows, at the time that he or she</u>
- makes the allegation, that the allegation: (A) is false
- 14 <u>and (B) may result in the person alleged to be the</u>
- 15 <u>biological father of a child being erroneously</u>
- adjudicated as the father of a child.
- 17 (b) Sentence. Paternity fraud is a Class A misdemeanor.
