- 4 Section 5. The Uniform Commercial Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 4-406.5 as follows:
- 6 (810 ILCS 5/4-406.5 new)
- Sec. 4-406.5. Unauthorized withdrawal or debit; notice.
- 8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Code,
- 9 <u>if the payor bank pays an item or otherwise debits the</u>
- 10 account of a depositor of the payor bank as a result of a
- 11 <u>deceptive practice as described in subdivision (C)(2) of</u>
- 12 <u>Section 17 of the Criminal Code of 1961, the affected</u>
- 13 <u>depositor must notify the payor bank of the unauthorized</u>
- 14 <u>withdrawal</u> or <u>debit</u> within 60 days after receiving a
- 15 <u>statement of account that disclosed that withdrawal or debit.</u>
- 16 (b) Following receipt of the timely notice by the payor
- 17 bank from the depositor, the payor bank is entitled to return
- 18 the item to the person or entity that presented the item for
- 19 payment and, in turn, that person or entity shall be entitled
- 20 <u>to return the item to any prior endorser or transferor of the</u>
- 21 <u>item.</u>
- 22 (c) The provisions of this Section shall be given effect
