- (b) By January 1, 2005, the Commission shall adopt rules
- 14 <u>concerning the allocation of new telephone numbers to</u>
- 15 <u>telecommunications carriers and requiring the periodic return</u>
- 16 for reallocation of numbers that have been allocated to a
- 17 <u>telecommunications carrier but are not being used by</u>
