- 1 AN ACT in relation to public employee benefits.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 14-114.1 as follows:
- 6 (40 ILCS 5/14-114.1 new)
- 7 Sec. 14-114.1. Plan of optional additional benefits and
- 8 contributions.
- 9 <u>(a) While this plan is in effect, an employee may</u>
- 10 <u>establish optional additional credit for additional benefits</u>
- 11 by electing in writing to make optional additional
- 12 <u>contributions either for future service under subsection (b)</u>
- or for previous service under subsection (c). An employee
- 14 may not elect to make additional contributions under both (b)
- 15 <u>and (c).</u>
- 16 (b) The optional additional contribution for service
- 17 <u>after the option is elected shall be 3% of salary,</u>
- 18 <u>contributed to the System on the same basis and under the</u>
- 19 <u>same conditions as required contributions under Sections</u>
