11 Upon the expiration of the term of a trustee who is in office on the effective date of this amendatory Act of 1975 12 or at the time of the publication of each decennial Federal 13 census of population, the successor shall be a resident 14 15 whichever county is entitled to such representation in order 16 to bring about the proportional representation required herein, and he shall be appointed by the appointing authority 17 of that county. Thereafter, each trustee shall be succeeded 18 19 by a resident of the same county who shall be appointed by the same appointing authority. Whenever a vacancy occurs in the board of trustees the appropriate appointing authority shall appoint some person to
