- 1 AN ACT concerning education.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Sex Education Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 130/3) (from Ch. 122, par. 698.53)
- 7 Sec. 3. A Sex Education Advisory Board is established
- 8 and shall consist of 9 members. The Director of Corrections,
- 9 the Director of Children and Family Services, the Director of
- 10 Public Health, and the Secretary of Human Services shall
- 11 serve as ex officio members of the Advisory Board. However,
- 12 any such Director or Secretary may designate an individual
