- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 361.5 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/361.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 361.5. Independent practice association and</u>
- 8 physician-hospital organization registration.
- 9 <u>(a) No person may maintain, operate, or represent itself</u>
- 10 <u>as an independent practice association or physician-hospital</u>
- organization, unless once every year the person registers the
- 12 <u>independent practice association or physician-hospital</u>
- organization with the Department.
- 14 (b) The provisions of this Section do not apply to:
- 15 <u>(1) persons providing independent practice</u>

 - (5) Hours of operation of each independent practice association or physician-hospital organization.
 - (6) Description of the grievance process for the independent practice association or physician-hospital organization.
 - (7) The number of covered lives for which the independent practice association or physician-hospital organization was responsible during the previous calendar year, if any.
 - (8) Written policies and procedures for protecting confidential information according to applicable State and federal laws including the federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996.
- 22 (9) Information required by the Department by rule 23 to establish adequate risk-based capital retention.
 - (d) If the Department finds that an independent practice association or physician-hospital organization is not in compliance with this Section, the Department shall issue a corrective action plan and allow a reasonable amount of time for compliance with the plan. If the independent practice association or physician-hospital organization does not come into compliance, the Department may issue a cease and desist order. Before issuing a cease and desist order under this Section, the Department shall provide the independent practice association or physician-hospital organization with a written notice of the reasons for the order and allow a
