AN ACT regarding school buses.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:
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Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections 10-20.37 and 34-18.26 as follows:
(105 ILCS 5/10-20.37 new)
Sec. 10-20.37. School bus idling policy. Each school board shall adopt a policy that prohibits a school bus that is in operation for the purpose of transporting students to or from school or a school-related function or activity from running on idle for more than one hour while the bus is parked. If the school bus driver violates this policy, then the board may fine the driver up to $\$ 500$ per violation. If a private school bus contractor rather than the school district provides the transportation, then the board may also fine the contractor up to $\$ 500$ per violation by the bus driver. The policy must provide for exceptions to the idling prohibition for zero emission school buses and emergency situations.
(105 ILCS 5/34-18.26 new)
Sec. 34-18.26. School bus idling policy. The board shall adopt a policy that prohibits a school bus that is in operation for the purpose of transporting students to or from school or a school-related function or activity from running on idle for more than one hour while the bus is parked. If the school bus driver violates this policy, then the board may fine the driver up to $\$ 500$ per violation. If a private school bus contractor rather than the school district provides the transportation, then the board may also fine the contractor up to $\$ 500$ per violation by the bus driver.
