- 8 requirements. To be considered a responsible bidder on a
- 9 <u>construction contract for purposes of this Code, a bidder</u>
- 10 <u>must comply with all of the following requirements and must</u>
- 11 present satisfactory evidence of that compliance to the
- 12 <u>appropriate construction agency:</u>
- 13 (1) The bidder must comply with all applicable laws
- 14 <u>concerning the bidder's entitlement to conduct business</u>
- in Illinois.
- 16 (2) The bidder must comply with all applicable
- 17 <u>provisions of the Prevailing Wage Act.</u>
- 18 (3) The bidder must comply with Subchapter VI
- 19 ("Equal Employment Opportunities") of Chapter 21 of Title

- 22 <u>amended by Executive Order No. 11375.</u>
- 23 <u>(4) The bidder must have a valid Federal Employer</u>
- 24 <u>Identification Number or, if an individual, a valid</u>
- 25 <u>Social Security Number.</u>
- 26 (5) The bidder must have a valid certificate of
- 27 <u>insurance showing the following coverages: general</u>
- 28 <u>liability, professional liability, product liability,</u>
- 29 <u>workers' compensation, completed operations, hazardous</u>
- 30 <u>occupation</u>, and automobile.
- 31 (6) The bidder and all bidder's subcontractors must
